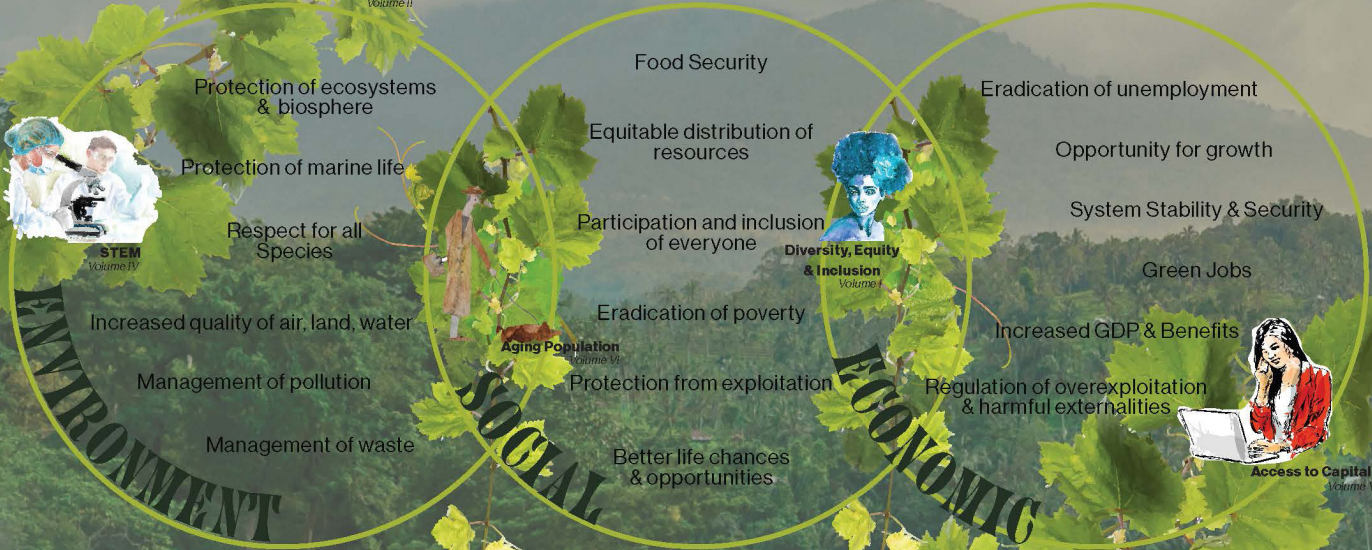

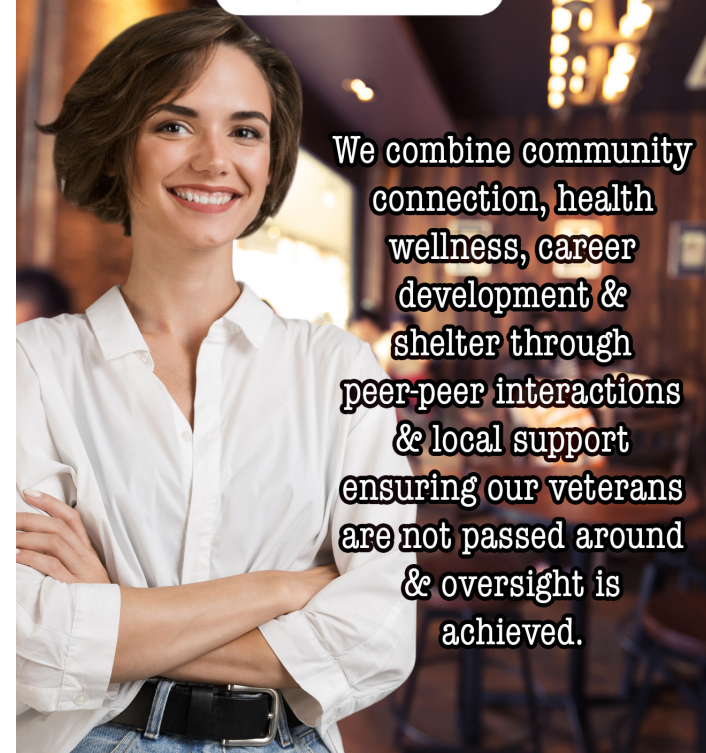

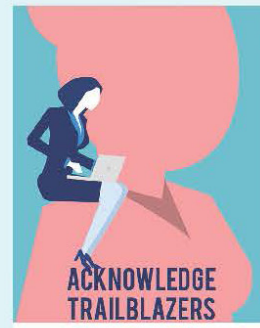

Inclusion isn't enough. Press for parity & strive for excellence in everything.

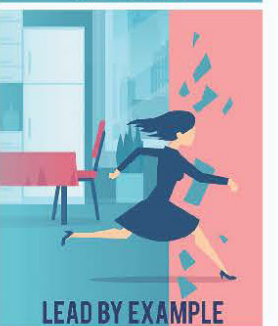
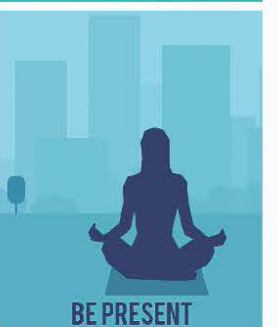

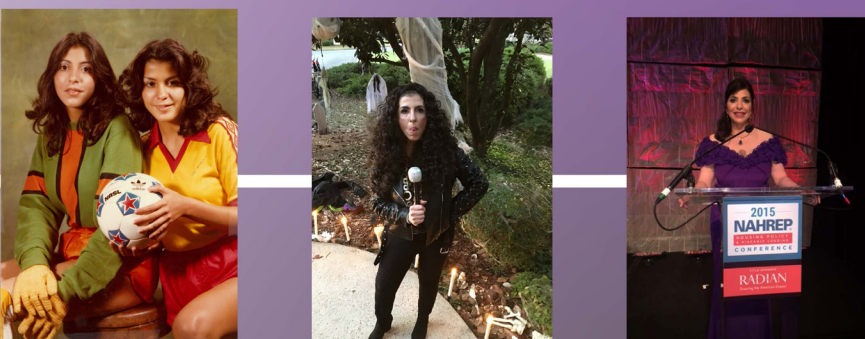
